### Biography

Christopher began studying piano at age four and composing at age six. He has since received critical acclaim and numerous national and international awards for his piano performances and compositions.

After winning a national piano competition at age nine, Christopher made his debut with Disney's Young Musicians Symphony Orchestra on national television. Since then, Christopher has appeared as a soloist, a chamber player and with orchestras in numerous venues throughout the country, such as Carnegie Hall, Lincoln Center, the Kennedy Center and the Hollywood Bowl.

Christopher received second place in the 2002 Young Concert Artists International Auditions. He was the youngest finalist and the only American pianist in the competition finals. This fall, Christopher will make both his orchestral and solo debut in Tokyo.
