Timothy is primarily interested in the union of music, art and literature, particularly in a historical context. He sees music as essential for explaining himself and connecting to other people.

In 2003, Timothy performed on the nationally broadcast radio show "*From the Top*." Having successfully composed a piano concerto, piano sonata and short piano pieces, he is currently working on his first symphony, a movement of which was read by the Juilliard Pre-College Orchestra.
