Her personal essays focus on the concept of physical loss and the quirks of family life, while her in-depth critical essays systematically analyze the work of other poets. Through her writing, Celeste seeks to inspire readers to observe the details in everyday life.

Biography

Celeste began her education at a Montessori school in Virginia. After moving to Florida, she enrolled in the gifted program in elementary school and skipped fifth grade. She was then placed in gifted and advanced classes in middle school, later enrolling in International Baccalaureate classes in high school.

Celeste hopes that her project impacts people who have dealt with illness or physical loss. She believes that by sharing her own experiences with disease she can bring others hope and encourage people to find an artistic outlet for their emotions.

Celeste has received local and national awards for her writing, most recently the Woodrow Wilson Fellowship at Johns Hopkins University and a Silver Award in Poetry from The Scholastic Art and Writing Awards.

Outside of school, Celeste loves to dance; she takes classes in ballet/pointe, jazz, hiphop, modern and choreography. For the last three years she has choreographed modern pieces for her studio's annual performance and she hopes to continue dancing at Johns Hopkins. Celeste also enjoys reading, scrapbooking, making jewelry, listening to music and shopping with her mom.
