Biography

Sarina began studying piano with her mother when she was 4 years old and took up the cello when she was 7. She has collaborated with the San Diego Symphony, the Buffalo Philharmonic Orchestra, the New City Sinfonia and the Northridge Symphony Orchestra. Most recently, she played Beethoven's #1 Piano Concerto with Detroit Symphony Orchestra's Civic Orchestra.

From 2004 to 2007, Sarina was the youngest member and assistant principal cellist in the San Diego Civic Youth Orchestra Symphony. In 2006 she accompanied the Civic Youth Orchestra on a European tour of Stockholm, Sweden; Helsinki, Finland; and St. Petersburg and Moscow, Russia. In 2006, Sarina gave her Carnegie Hall debut.

Sarina's performances have been broadcast on National Public Radio and the PBS television show *From the Top, Live from Carnegie Hall*. Her future engagements include an appearance as a guest artist in the 2009-2010 season for the Corpus Christi Symphony and with the California Symphony in May 2010.

Sarina's hobbies include swimming, reading fantasy and mystery books and drawing.
